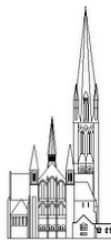

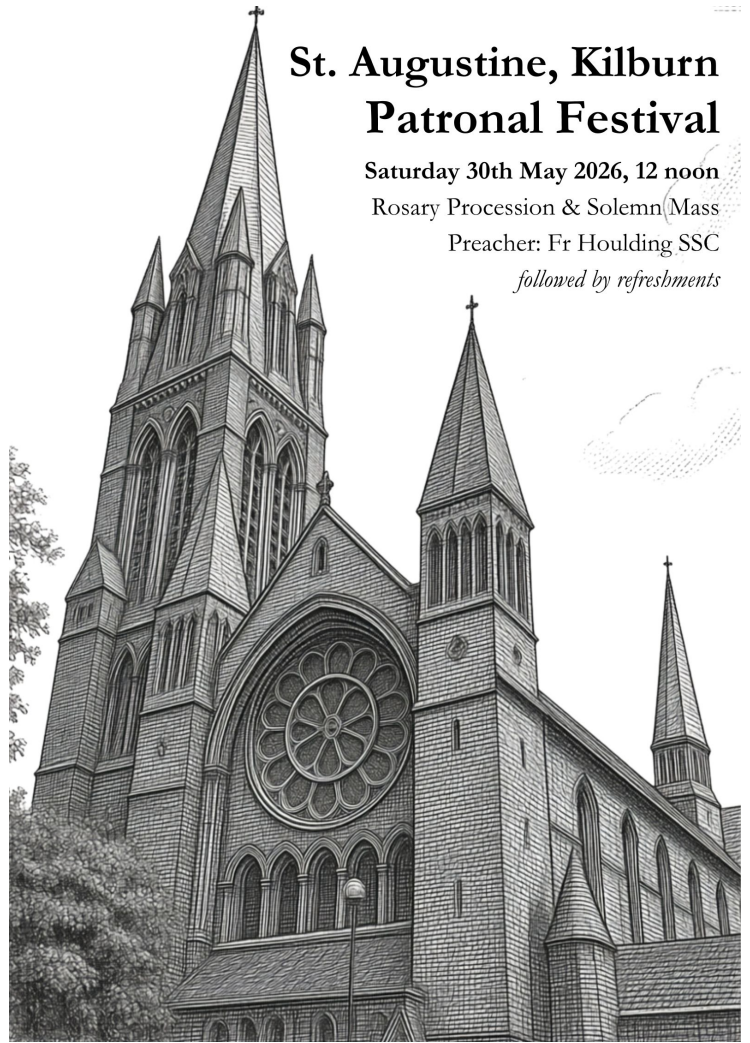
PREPARING FOR THE APCM – 10th May 2026
